## **FROM YOUR PARISH PRIEST**

My dear friends,

### **FAREWELL**

Sometimes I do wonder whether I've harped on rather too much about my eventual retirement, but it has always been for a reason. It's now upon us. After Sunday June 17th I am on leave until the weekend of Saturday June 30th & Sunday July 1st. As I wrote last month, we have two ordinations, Sally Turnbull as Priest on the Saturday at 5.30 pm in the Cathedral, and Julia Hepburn as Deacon on the Sunday morning at 10.30, again in the Cathedral. On the Sunday evening, at 6.00 pm, Sally will celebrate Holy Communion for the first time, at St. Hilary's Church Spridlington. Julia will be the Deacon and I shall preach for the last time.

My main reason for announcing my retirement so soon was to encourage people to put quickly into place the procedures for finding a successor. The Church of England can be slow over this. Many parishes are without a parish priest for a long time, and those of you who live in the Springline Parish know this yourselves. Four other parish priests in the diocese retire at the same time as me; we were all born in the "bulge" year of 1947.

The process of finding a successor has started. Ask your churchwardens if you wish to know how it is progressing. Not only do our villages and communities need a parish priest; our fine Ministry Team needs and deserves a leader.

The service at Spridlington on April 29th was a wonderful affirmation of my time in our parishes, and I thank you for it. I have enjoyed my ministry here immensely, and feel that to have been here and served in these villages has been a real blessing to me. As I write, I am on Sundays doing the rounds of all our churches for the final time. One churchwarden suggested printing tee-shirts for the "Farewell Tour"!

People were very generous. I shall use the bulk of your very kind gift on April 29th to buy myself a Brennan. This is a device to help me organise my large collection of recorded music. You've perhaps seen them advertised.

What shall I do in retirement? Music, in many and various ways. Some travel, possibly even a traditional pilgrimage at some stage. A lot of staring out to sea, no doubt. God will not let me go, and I wait to see how this pans out.

Somebody once wrote to me following a Signpost letter, objecting to my monthly 'God-talk'. It was an anonymous letter, so I couldn't reply. But I make no apologies for it. To many people's surprise, religion is hot news nowadays. I'd rather that God were hot news, because I have seen God, who is Love (and I don't know a better definition of God than that) at work in many and various ways in my time here, both in and out of church. I do hope you'll continue to support your churches, and I do hope you'll all continue both to look out for and to discover where this God of Love is in your lives.

# GLENTHAM & CAENBY

## GLENTHAM PARISH COUNCIL

The Annual Parish Meeting was held in the Village Hall on 3rd May. A report prepared by outgoing Council Chairman Neil Simpson was read by new Chairman Alan Lakeman. A financial report was also made by the Clerk and both reports are reproduced below. Full minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting and the Annual Parish Council Meeting are displayed on the notice boards and on the website.

### CHAIRMAN'S REPORT 2012

#### **Personnel**

Council membership is up to strength with the appointment of Mark Dowthwaite in June & Martin Kuhl in November.

#### **Attendance**

Attendance throughout the year was generally satisfactory with almost all members achieving better than 66% attendance and every meeting quorate. (Clerk has a detailed analysis of attendance)

#### **Financial Matters**

The precept for the coming year was held to last year's level, without a reduction in provision. This was due, in great part, to the diligence of the Clerk in recognising cost savings and monitoring the situation. The current year's expenditure has been slightly less than expected and allows us to augment our reserves. More detailed information will be included in the Clerk's report.

#### **Planning**

There were a total of 7 planning applications during the year. None were for new residential buildings, two were for commercial enterprises (Cherry Tree Farm & Barff Farm) and the remainder were for extensions to existing properties or tree management issues. All were approved but reservations were noted for the Cherry Tree project. A proposal to create a wind farm to the west of the A15 was notified and a number of meetings, organised by Bishop Norton, were held to establish a protest campaign. This is on-going and will continue to be monitored by Council.

#### **Achievements**

During the year the Council has:

- Completed a Community Flood Plan to ensure the safety of the most vulnerable residents. This included the purchase of various items of safety and prevention equipment.
- Purchased flower tubs and picnic benches for the area around the village hall and green
- Produced a number of local walks leaflets
- Moved closer to achieving Quality Council Accreditation
- Commenced a Neighbourhood Plan to ensure future Planning Applications are appropriate and sustainable
- Applied/applying for grants to purchase:
  - Materials to create parking spaces around village hall
  - Materials to replace playground fence with metal railings
  - Decorations and tableware etc for Jubilee street party
  - Extra lighting for village green
  - Snow management equipment



## **CLERK'S FINANCIAL REPORT FOR ANNUAL PARISH MEETING 3RD MAY**

The annual accounts were presented to the Council on 5th April 2012 and accepted unconditionally. An internal audit was conducted by Mrs Kathy Mannion of Glenthams, and was reported as satisfactory with a minor adjustment to the Assets Management Register. The Annual Return is currently in preparation in readiness for a full external audit by Government appointed chartered accountants Clement Keyes. Electors have the right to examine the Council's finances between 22nd May and 22nd June, and a notice to this effect is displayed on both notice boards. Last year's audit was found to be satisfactory.

The Council started the financial year 2011-12 with funds of £ 6044.11 and ended the year with £ 5944.71. A decision was taken to set the precept at £ 5891.00 for the second year running, offering council tax payers a level of stability in uncertain times.

Some items were under spent against budget due to careful negotiation; for example £631.34 was saved on grass cutting, and £149.67 was saved on insurance without loss of cover. On the other hand the Council received £23.87 less than anticipated, due to poor interest rates.

Internet banking is now available to authorised Councillors and Clerk, who can monitor the accounts but without the authority to manipulate them, thus satisfying the Financial Regulations.

In the Clerk's opinion, the Council is acting prudently and there are adequate reserves for planned requirements and most contingencies.

I have had positive feedback from readers about the email scams some of us have experienced which I gave reassurance/advice in the last magazine. I have since had calls asking for advice regarding letter Scams, please read the information below for further advice.

### **Hong Kong Fraud Scam - Inheritance Scam**

Please be aware that we are getting reports of a letter and/or telephone scam currently targeting the areas of North Hykeham and Louth. This may move onto other areas as the scammers work their way through telephone/address databases.

**Scam Details** The letter explains that a relative has died leaving their will 'intestate' (not making a will before they died) for you as a relative to 'split' the high value figure with the letter writer and claim 50% of the funds.

**Please do not fall in to the trap of giving your bank details or credit cards details to claim your share. This is completely fraudulent and will result in funds being taken from your personal bank account or credit card.**

Of concern is that a number of elderly residents have forwarded their letters to their local Neighbourhood Policing Team asking for further advice. Please ensure that any elderly relatives or residents are aware that they may be contacted in this way and to simply throw the letters away or replace the telephone handset.

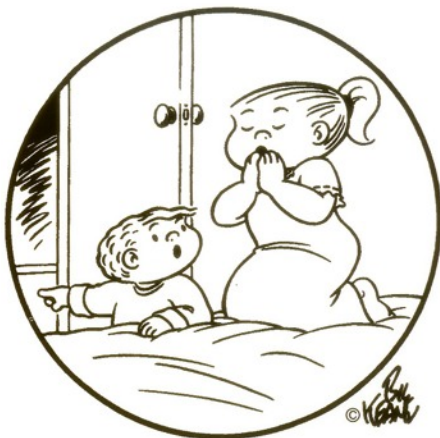
