#### FROM THE RECTOR

"September so often feels like a time for new beginnings..."

Dear Friends,

You might recall these words, which appeared in the parish letter that my colleague, Julia Hepburn, prepared for the September issue. Julia wasn't to know this at the time of writing her letter but upon publication her words struck something of a chord with my family and I.

As you may know, my wife, Katie, is due to embark on a new course of academic study this month, and having recently celebrated the third anniversary of our arrival in the parishes I too am now anticipating a totally unexpected new beginning: at the start of next month I will sadly be leaving the Springline Parish and Owmby Group to take up the role of Diocesan Communications Officer, a position that will be based at Edward King House in Lincoln.

I am sure you will appreciate that a great deal of careful thought and prayerful discernment was involved in my application for this post, but I felt - and I feel - called to this opportunity to apply my ministerial (and pre-ordination publishing and radio) experience in helping the Diocese as a whole to develop disciples and achieve continued growth and development. [As part of this role I hope to be able to highlight the continued good work in our parishes.]

I would like to think that you, like us, will have happy memories of our time with you here. As well as the joy of getting to know so many of you, we have been very grateful for your support, both prayerful and practical. For me, I will always cherish the beauty, peace and the opportunities to be found in our parishes. A particular memory for me is of my night spent in a stable for charity in December 2012; I really enjoyed - and I certainly benefited from - our Lenten walks across the parishes as preparation for Holy Week and Easter back in 2014; and it has been very good to welcome you into our home for coffee mornings and, this year, for breakfast following our outdoor service in Hackthorn as we greeted the dawn of Easter morning. In addition, I have been grateful to be invited to officiate at such special services as baptisms, weddings and funerals, and I have valued my time as a governor in two of our five primary schools, plus the opportunity to lead assemblies and spend time in class.

We will be very sorry to say 'goodbye' to you when the time comes, at the beginning of next month, but we hope that, as I continue to pray for the life and ministry of our parishes here, so you will also hold us in your prayers and that you will all wish us well ahead of this new beginning. (Further details will follow with regard to arrangements for the interregnum.)

So, thank you all again for your love, your welcome and your support over the past three years. I know that our ministry team, churchwardens, parochial church council members and congregations will continue to work hard to serve God and you all in our parishes, and my family and I have been grateful for our time in the Springline Parish and Owmby Group.

#### **BISHOP OF LINCOLN'S LETTER**

Dear friends.

I am writing this letter to you just after our first diocesan synod meeting of a new triennium, held early in September. By the time you read this we will have welcomed many people, from across the diocese, to the Saints in Every Generation event in the Cathedral. Two quite different occasions, but both a sign of our commitment to each other as members together of the family of God here in greater Lincolnshire.

As you know, as a diocese we have committed ourselves to being faithful in worship, confident in discipleship and joyful in service. This year has seen the launch of our discipleship programme, aimed at helping all of us to think and pray about the particular and distinct contribution we can make to the life of the world and in response to God's call. One of the highlights of Saints in Every Generation was the opportunity for everyone present to pledge to do one thing, however large or small, which would take them further on their journey towards confident discipleship. I would like to thank everyone who attended and assure you that I will read each of the pledges you so faithfully gave.

This time of year is often associated with new beginnings, and that is certainly the case in the life of the diocese this year. I am delighted that we will soon be welcoming the Reverend Mark Steadman as the next Archdeacon of Stow and Lindsey. Mark will be installed at evensong in the Cathedral on 10th October. All are most welcome to attend. If you would like to do so, please let the precentor's office know so that everyone can be welcomed and accommodated (01522 561632).

Later in the year, we will welcome the Reverend Dr Nicholas Chamberlain among us as suffragan bishop of Grantham. I've written elsewhere of my belief that Dr Chamberlain brings fabulous gifts, a truly pastoral heart, a profound faith and indefatigable dedication to the mission and purpose of the Church. I am gratified that we have been able to attract a priest of his calibre to be bishop of Grantham, and I ask you to hold him in your prayers as he prepares for his ordination to the episcopate on 19 November.

Alongside this, there is also a significant farewell to be said as Tim Barker prepares to leave the diocese after 17 years of faithful service as parish priest and then archdeacon. As Tim moves to his new post of Dean of Guernsey and Rector of St André de la Pommaraye later in the autumn, he and Judy will go with our love blessings and a huge debt of gratitude for all that they have given to the diocese.

NOTES ON COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 3rd September 2015

The September Parish Council meeting took place on 3rd September and the full Council were in attendance. Updates on Council matters are as follows:

**Dog Fouling** - the Council politely ask that dog owners please clear up after their pets, particularly in the Little Hill area - a stock of waste bags is available for owners and is located at the village hall.

**Childrens' Playground** - the bench in the playground has been upgraded, and the external play equipment inspection has been carried out. Parishioners should be aware that there may be some works in the playground in the next few weeks.

**Bus Shelter** - the Council are pleased with the new bus shelter which was installed in time for the first day of the school term. The Council have claimed £2,750.00 in grants towards the shelter and hopefully all parishioners will agree that it is an asset for the parish.

**Nature Project** - following a donation of £435.00 from the Glentham & District Gardeners' Club - which the Council were sorry to hear had closed due to lack of numbers, the Council are looking to undertake a project to sow wildflowers in areas of the parish. More on this project as it progresses!

**Memorial Stone** - the Council agreed that this project is no longer financially viable, however alternative schemes will be discussed at future meetings.

**Parish Plan Refresh** - the Council discussed the purpose of parish and neighbourhood plans and after lengthy discussion were agreed that the parish plan would not be refreshed. Glentham has been designated as a small village within the new Local Plan. Cllr Summers urges all parishioners to submit views when consultation on the Local Plan opens in October 2015.

**Good Neighbour Scheme** - the Council are considering implementation of the Good Neighbour Scheme which will be delivered by groups of volunteers.
